What will you study in BTCL?

In the first year:

- Bible Study Methods

- Personal Spiritual Life

In the second year:

- Bible Doctrine (theology)
- Missions, Evangelism and Discipleship
- Teaching Principles and Processes
- Servant Leadership



What do you need to participate in BTCL?

Your commitment to faithful class attendance is essential to getting the most out of BTCL. Classes meet each **Tuesday evening**, 6-9 pm, throughout the school year. We also meet one or two Saturdays per semester. Classes begin on **Tuesday, Aug. 9, 2022**.
