zealous followers of the priesthood and the Temple..

18 Some Sadducees (who say that there is no resurrection)

as they did not think the law of Moses mentioned it..

*came to Jesus, and began questioning Him,

saying, 19 "Teacher, Moses wrote for us that IF A MAN'S BROTHER

DIES and leaves behind a wife AND LEAVES NO CHILD, HIS BROTHER

SHOULD MARRY THE WIFE AND RAISE UP CHILDREN TO HIS

BROTHER. 20 There were seven brothers; and the first took a

wife, and died leaving no children. 21 The second one married

her, and died leaving behind no children; and the third

likewise; 22 and so all seven left no children. Last of all the

woman died also. 23 In the resurrection, when they rise again,

which one's wife will she be? For all seven had married

her." 24 Jesus said to them, "Is this not the reason you are

mistaken, that you do not understand the Scriptures or the

power of God? 25 For when they rise from the dead, they

neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in

heaven. 26 But regarding the fact that the dead rise again,

have you not read in the book of Moses, in

the passage about the burning bush, how God spoke to him,

saying, 'I AM' THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, AND THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND

THE GOD OF JACOB'? 27 He is not the God of the dead, but of

the living; you are greatly mistaken."

2. assumptions:

1. The law says nothing about the resurrection

2. Heaven is no different than earth

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Assumption 1

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heaven is not like earth..

and the bible does speak about the resurrection

not "I was" but "I am"...

meaning that Abraham Isaac and Jacob were alive on the other side.
