

Mark 14:32 - 43 The Garden Of Gethsemane

³² They *came to a place named Gethsemane; and He *said

to His disciples, "Sit here until I have prayed." ³³ And He

*took with Him Peter and James and John, and began to be

very distressed and troubled. ³⁴ And He *said to them, "My

soul is deeply grieved to the point of death; remain here and

keep watch." ³⁵ And He went a little beyond *them*, and fell to

the ground and *began* to pray that (if it were possible,) the

hour might pass Him by. ³⁶ And He was saying, "Abba!

Father! All things are possible for You; remove this cup from

Me; yet not what I will, but what You will." ³⁷ And He *came

and *found them sleeping, and *said to Peter, "Simon, are

you asleep? Could you not keep watch for one hour? ³⁸ Keep

watching and praying that you may not come into

temptation; the spirit is willing, but the flesh is

weak." ³⁹ Again He went away and prayed, saying the

same words. ⁴⁰ And again He came and found them sleeping,

for their eyes were very heavy; and they did not know what

to answer Him. ⁴¹ And He *came the third time, and *said to

them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? It is enough; the

hour has come; behold, the Son of Man is being betrayed

into the hands of sinners. ⁴² Get up, let us be going; behold,

the one who betrays Me is at hand!"
