

Romans 10:9-11

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord,
and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the
dead, you will be saved; ¹⁰ for with the heart a person

believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he
confesses, resulting in salvation. ¹¹ For the Scripture says,

"imputed Righteousness
thus 'salvation'"

Such faith will not fail you — "WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED."

What does it mean "to be saved"?

1. It is something done by God. "Saved" is a passive verb. The subject is acted upon.
Man is saved by divine intervention (Eph. 2:8-9)

2. Saved from what?

- The guilt of sin
- The alienation of sin... its darkness and death .. spiritual death
- The wage of sin... "death" .. physical death
- The punishment of sin ... Hell.. the lake of fire

3. Saved by what? "Jesus" Two historic events

- the incarnation = "Jesus is Lord" Christmas
- the cross = "raised from the dead" Easter

4. Saved through what? Faith alone in the work of Christ

- Faith is personal "believe in your heart"
- Faith is public "confess with your mouth"
