

Proverbs 13:10-15 Five Virtues 2 Results

Disrespect of Authority — 10 Through insolence comes nothing but strife, Because those in leadership will fight to maintain order

The teachable become WISE — But wisdom is with those who receive counsel.

11 Wealth obtained by fraud dwindles, literally: "vanity" An absence of hard work
 But the one who gathers by labor increases it. Because there is no persistent work ethic...no continued income to build upon.

literally "upon the hand"
 i.e. one who works hard

12 Hope deferred makes the heart sick,
 But desire fulfilled is a tree of life. his income grows and progresses as he labors.

"Disappointment"
 Breaks your heart
 Successful ambition is like divine life...

13 The one who despises the word will be in debt to it, i.e. Just as you MUST pay debts, a disobedient man will have to obey to escape a life of pain
 But the one who fears the commandment will be rewarded.

how much easier to obey the word and enjoy blessing and not pain.

14 The teaching of the wise is a fountain of life,
 To turn aside from the snare of death. The Bible protects from hidden unexpected dangers...

15 Good understanding produces favor, The results of obeying the Bible or not obeying.
 But the way of the treacherous is hard.
