

Unit 1: In the Beginning

Unit Description: The story begins with God creating everything from nothing. Of all of God's perfect creation, people were most special, alone being made in God's image. All that God created was created to reveal God's glory—how amazing He is.

Big Picture Question: Why did God create everything? God created everything for His glory and our good.

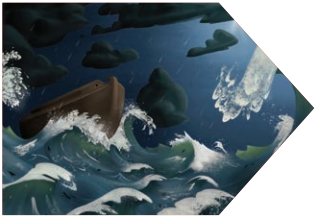
Big Picture Question: What does it mean to sin? To sin is to think, speak, or behave in any way that goes against God and His commands.

Unit 3: God's Rescue Plan

Unit Description: God's solution for sin, which He promised in Eden, became clearer when God made a covenant with Abraham. God promised to bring the Rescuer through Abraham's family. This family was far from perfect and endured great adversity, but through it all, God remained faithful, revealing that nothing could stop His plan.

Big Picture Question: Who is in control of everything? God is in control of everything in heaven and on earth. Nothing is outside of God's good plan.
